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## **Abstract**

The Ethical behavior is the essence of human life. The human life must make ethical decisions. The ethical behavior is the center of social life as well as the center of the personal life for individuals. It is one of the features for the decent person.

The field of ethical behavior has occupied a prominence area in the modern psychology due to what the society suffered especially from social, economic, and political problems.

Rest model (1984) is the most models that have been received well in the field of ethical behavior.

The Determinants of ethical behavior has been determined from the moral heritage in the knowledgeable developmental fields as well as the social and behavioral aspects of learning in addition to the Psychoanalysis, and Social Psychology.

Such model gives a more comprehensive vision of moral from the one-dimensional model like the Kohlberg model, which focused only on moral judgment.

The ethical behavior determines with four determinants as following: (Moral Sensitivity - Moral Judgment - Moral Motivation - Moral Character).

Sadler says that the Moral Sensitivity is the first nucleus of ethical behavior. Rests defines the Moral Sensitivity as a mix of one's realization for ethical issues and how interact and treat with such issues from a sentimental prospective inside the social context.
